



2022 Mission Servants Ministry Year Summary

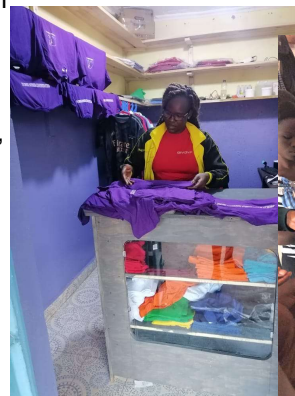

Thank you so much for standing with Mission Servants Ministry (MSM) through our 16th year serving Jesus Christ by loving vulnerable children and families. Things have migrated back towards normal in 2022 in Kenya and Uganda with regard to the Covid Pandemic but the major challenge has been price inflation of everything, especially food products. Poor crop yield early in 2022 also created shortages of food and radically higher prices. This has made it difficult on all families to pay school fees and simply live. We thank God for using us to continue to promote the welfare of all the 1000+ children in the schools and 100+ in and through the Children's Homes sponsored by MSM. All the Children that MSM sponsors from the Lord's Servants Home (LSH) in Kenya and Child Redeemed Mission Home (CRM) in Uganda were able to continue with school and complete the 2022 school year. The two schools that MSM assists, Promise Primary (PPS) and Rock View Primary (RVPS) were hampered financially due to the food shortages and higher prices but ended the year strong with high outlook for the 2023 school year and with big plans.

In summary, the 2022 MSM agenda...

- To provide for the education of the sponsored children at the Lord's Servants Home (LSH) in Kenya,
- Support life and operations at Child Redeemed Mission Home (CRM) in Uganda,
- Impact the community by helping Promise Primary School (Nursery - Grade 7) improve and become financially stable,
- Serve the Rock View Primary School (Nursery -Grade 7) through help to overcome barrier needs,
- Help all the older kids that have finished general schooling to move ahead in further training, career, or a business start-up.
- Serve and support the Christian outreach in the Teso area.
- Show the Love of Christ to the communities and people near the homes.

Older Kids...Opportunities for a bright future. It is an MSM goal to assist our sponsored Children to enter adult life with an opportunity to be a productive member of society according to their potential and we plan, fund, and assist in opportunities and encouragement. Unlike the vast majority of children in Africa, finishing High School is a given and Trade School, College, and University are some real options for many kids as well as help starting businesses through MSM. Many young adults are being helped to higher education and better start in life. Some stories from 2022 are....Micah, aged 6 when MSM began sponsoring him, graduated from college with a degree in IT and Communications and just landed a job in Nairobi. Sarah finished a business degree and started a Branding Design / Printing business and is establishing herself as the "Go to" for schools and sports organization in her area. A Beauty Salon was established in Uganda as a place to train and work for some of our girls who want that type of work, Brian in Kenya is in Civil Engineering school and has started a small "Tree to Lumber" business. Bosco, Emma, Julius, Edinasi, and others were assisted with Driving Licensing, Sewing Machines, Construction Tools, and Baking Equipment to earn a living as an example. Tapenesi is in Veterinary School, Eresi in Nursing School, Fidelis, Joseph, and Gabriel are in Engineering school, and Sharon and Brigitte are in Travel Advising school to name some.



Child Redeemed Mission Home Update.... Emma Ssengoba and a team of 2 Social Workers, 2 Guards, and Cook have managed the CRM home well and started 2022 by welcoming 10 new children into the CRM family. Their duties involve creating and promoting a Christian, healthy environment and manage the children towards succeeding at school. Keeping up with school, home, and governmental requirements are quite a job. Emma and his wife Gorretti are also leaders in the Bwase Redeemed Church (BRC) located on CRM grounds. BRC is a bright spot in the community and is bringing people to know The Lord and have baptized over 200 people in the last few years. They have also established an impressive and peaceful collection of cows, pigs, goats, chickens, and rabbits, fruit trees, and garden at CRM which the kids help with and learn from.



Lord Servants Home (LSH) Update.... Ken and Judy Mudenyo do a great job directing and serving the Lord's Servants Home and Bridgeway Hope Academy (BHA) as well as mentoring all the MSM sponsored kids. Most of the kids are in High School or beyond and keeping track of them and helping when needed is a priority shared with MSM. 7 kids graduated in 2022 and 11 remain in school while 21 are in college for a variety of studies, working in chosen careers like teaching and medical, starting businesses, or starting families.



Trips. MSM made one trip to the LSH Home in Kenya and two trips to the CRM home in Uganda. The trip to LSH was the first since Covid started and the team was busy with repairs and organizing painting and upkeep when they were not reconnecting with all the kids and friends there. Several new tables were built for partner churches and individuals were built up through church leadership and Bible classes. In Uganda, trips in February and August were highly focused on kids. There were 10 new ones that we first met then, shared great times with kids at the home, and mentored older ones that were deciding how best to prepare for adulthood and learning about how to start businesses. We completed plenty of repairs, lighting upgrades at the schools, training, and loads of encouragement.



Promise Primary School Partnership. MSM acts in a partner arrangement to provide management mentoring and financial assistance to PPS, located in a village, Nabwigulu, near to CRM. This is also where all the CRM kids from Nursery to Grade 7 attend school.

A monumental advance was made by PPS in 2022. MSM provided loans to purchase 4 small neighboring plots of land and a small pasturing plot. These purchases finalized the nearly 5 acre compound and allowed the installation of a chain link bordering fence, construction of an impressive front wall and steel sliding gate, and guard house. A night guard and two dogs are watching. The result is a secure school compound, especially important for the 150 children expected to be boarding there by 2024. This process took a few



years to complete and we Praise God. Promise Primary is performing extremely well and in 2022 garnered notice as a top school in the region for testing kids into High School. That's the key job for a Primary School!



Rock View Primary School Partnership. MSM funded new beds for the children boarding at the school. They had been previously sleeping on the floor and without benefit of mosquito nets. Almost 100 new desks were built for RVPS and PPS which provided seats for up to 200 more students. RVPS is a real bright spot in the outskirts of the Kasolwe community as there are no other schools near by. MSM has funded several buildings over the years.



Community Projects, Uganda...Partnership with Bwase Redeemed Church. A double cataract surgery was sponsored for a community widow who was virtually blind. A construction loan and technical advice was given to a local High School to allow them to drill a deep well and



install water treatment equipment to provide clean safe drinking water to the school of 1500 students. Outbreaks of sicknesses were common due to poor water quality coming from the public supply. Several seminars on topics such as parenting, business practices, and health were provided to the communities. A medical clinic in a village near RVPS was given a loan to purchase clinical equipment and to establish a sick room at CRM. Working with partners is a critical path to success for mission work, especially when being directed from a distance.

Community Projects, Kenya...Partnership with local leaders to rebuild community water sources. MSM has funded many pedestrian bridges, road culverts, and water source projects in the community around the Lord's Servants Home. In 2022 seven projects were completed to rebuild fouled, unproductive, and unhealthy Ground Water Spring or Dug Well Sources for community use. Two more projects are currently in process. The number of people benefiting from these projects are numbered in the multi thousands. African saying....Water is Life! Maji ni Uhai sana.



Teso People Group Evangelism. MSM has been involved in partnership with an Ugandan Teso Ministry to support the Kingdom goal to reach the Kenyan Teso People for Christ since 2013 when it was listed as Unreached by the IMB. MSM continued in 2022 to provide Mentorship, Solar powered audio Bibles in Ateso language, Projectors to show the Jesus Film, Printed material, and transportation support. Arguably, the Kenyan Teso People Group can now be considered reached through inspired efforts on the ground and God's Grace. Hundreds of Bible study groups have been established and many dozens of leaders have been trained and churches planted. The souls reached for Christ in the last 10 years are uncountable. MSM became involved because the Teso region is located midway and along the route between the LSH and CRM homes and it was noticed to be an Unreached area and the Holy Spirit put everyone together. Amazing!

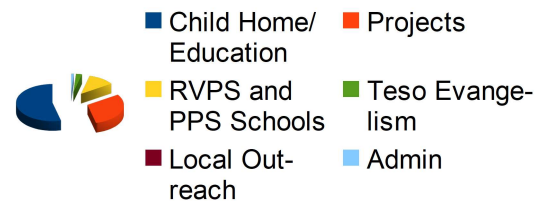

2022 Financial summary. MSM continues to be very efficient with funds. Over 98% of the money spent in 2022 by MSM went to tangible work such as mission specific supplies, Home and School operations, projects, outreach, trips, evangelism, and education....a total of roughly \$190,000. Less than 2% of that total expenditures are on non program items such as for bank/money transfer fees, NGO fees, and accounting. This efficiency is possible for several reasons...

- MSM is all volunteer and has no salaries or compensation. Trip volunteers fund their own travel.
- MSM works through and employs nationals at the homes, schools, and in implementing projects.
- MSM is very hands on, spending funds directly and accountably.
- MSM has no fund raising expenses, relying instead on the Holy Spirit to work through donors to provide what we need.



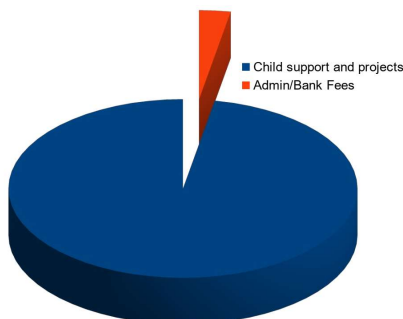
Partner Ministries. We are blessed with ministry partners such as **The Lord's Ministries, Restoring Vision, Teso Faith Pentecostal, Bwase Redeemed Church, Love Exchange United, Lyavo Bible Church, World Vision, and others...**working together on projects at schools and communities. This is rewarding to work with other groups...many hands and hearts make light work!

In 2023....What do we see... We expect normal operations throughout the year as planned, and sponsored schools will bless families and illuminate the Gospel of Christ.

- Five New kids will be joining the CRM family in January and 11 kids have graduated High School and will begin life after schooling.
- We will continue to help the 11 new graduates plus roughly 20 other older kids already involved with higher education and businesses so they can thrive as productive independent adult citizens.
- We plan to further improve the infrastructure of Promise Primary school by adding 4 Dorm Rooms which will free up two more classrooms, drill a well and make treated water, and obtain electrical power to the compound.
- We expect to carry on with at least two trips and numerous projects for our communities with our partners.
- We will continue to support the evangelism efforts by our partners in the Teso region and see that mature.
